The CLM Program empowers women to lift themselves, and their families, out of poverty and build sustainable livelihoods. 1,000 Mothers have embarked on this path, each of them exhibiting remarkable strength and resilience. Transforming their lives and their family's future.

FROM ULTRA POVERTY TO SELF-SUFFICIENCY

Chemen Lavi Miyò (CLM) is an 18-month accompaniment program that helps women experiencing abject hopelessness, lifts themselves to a level of self-sufficiency.

Participants develop the skills and confidence to run their chosen micro-enterprises, making it possible for them to feed their families daily, send their kids to school, build a metal roof over their home, install a latrine, and have access to safe water.

BEFORE CLM

These women were ...



Unable to feed their families daily.

Living isolated in flimsy, leaky huts.
Without income or hope for the future.
